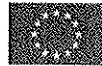

With reference to the above mentioned registration number, I am pleased to inform you that based on the decision of the Joint Steering Committee (JSC) of the Hungary-Romania Cross-border Co-operation Programme at the JSC meeting on 27-28 July 2010 and of the Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) at the JMC meeting on 15 November 2010 your Project Proposal have been selected to be co-financed by the Programme.

The amount of ERDF awarded cannot exceed the maximum of **68 000,00** EUR.

Total amount of the approved budget: **80 000,00** EUR

I would like to inform you that the JSC set the following special conditions for your Project Proposal:

A declaration must be submitted by the Lead Partner and the Project Partner that they will undertake the following obligations:

1. The relevant authorities (environmental entities) will be informed regarding the performed activities. In the end of the project these entities must be provided with a report containing the findings and results (Romanian side).

Moreover, regarding the activities on the Romanian side, the following documents must be submitted:

1. Support letter from the Central Authority for Waters
2. Support letter from the National environment Protection Agency, or Local Environmental Protection Agency



3. Support letter of the respective authority in charge of the natural protected areas and natural parks

With reference to the above and to the rules governing the Programme, the selected proposal has to be complemented with the documents listed under the special conditions, as well as the relevant obligatory documents presented in the "List of documents to be submitted for the conclusion of ERDF Subsidy Contract".

The above documents have to be submitted to the JTS within maximum 30 days in one original copy from the receipt of the present letter, to the below address:
